North American Plugfest scheduled for May 2011

Planning has started for the next North American plugfest which will be held at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln, Nebraska, USA. The event is hosted by the Nebraska Tractor Test Laboratory. The dates of the plugfest will be May 10 and 11, 2011. This event brings together engineers from any number of companies that produce electronic devices which communicate with each other using the ISOBUS (ISO 11783) communication standard. It is an informal event where these devices can be interconnected with devices from other companies to ensure that the communications work properly. Currently there are two plugfests per year coordinated by the AEF e.V., one in Europe in the Fall and one in North America in the Spring.

We are anticipating a big turnout for the event which last year hosted over 90 participants with forty separate ISOBUS devices. May 12th will be reserved for AEF Engineering and Implementation and Conformance Testing Project Team meetings. Start your planning now to attend the Spring 2011 plugfest in Nebraska.
